ADVISORY COMMITTEES

The Gore Board of Education may, from time to time, appoint private citizens as official Advisory Committees to the board or the board may use the Gore School Community Council.

Any recommendations of such committees or council are advisory only and will not be binding upon the board of education. Following the completion of specific functions, the committees shall be dismissed. Advisory committees shall serve as a two-way channel of communication and shall have the following specific purposes:

- 1. To study questions concerning the Gore Public School System submitted to the committee by the board of education,
- 2. To assist interpreting public opinion, and
- 3. To assist the board in explaining issues and problems to the community
