HEALTH PERSONNEL

The Gore Board of Education recognizes the existence of a close working relationship between school employees and students. The board, therefore, shall require school employees to provide evidence of freedom from communicable diseases. The board shall require any school employee to complete a physical examination whenever the board believes it to be in the best interest of the school system. The physical examination shall be performed by a physician who may be chosen and compensated by the board.

The attached regulations shall govern the identification, prevention, and control of Tuberculosis and diseases related to the Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) commonly referred to as Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS).
