CUSTODIAL AND NONCUSTODIAL PARENTAL RIGHTS

It is the policy of the Gore Board of Education that a parent who is awarded legal custody of a child by court action shall file a copy of the court decree awarding such custody with the school. If the custodial parent does not wish the child to be released to the noncustodial parent, an appropriate written instruction should also be filed with the school.

All staff members are instructed to refer any questions to the appropriate building principal or the superintendent.

Absent a court decree to the contrary, both natural parents have the right to view the student's school records; to receive school progress reports; to visit the child briefly at school; and to participate in parent and teacher conferences

(not necessarily together in the same conference).
