EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES CHEERLEADING (REGULATION)

- 1. Each cheerleader will attend every football and basketball game unless the cheerleader's absence has been previously excused by the sponsor.
- 2. Cheerleaders will ride the bus to and from every game unless previous arrangements are made with the sponsor.
- 3. Cheerleaders will be on the field or court at the beginning buzzer. They will remain there until the half- time buzzer. They will be back on the field or court when the buzzer sounds for the last half and remain until the final buzzer or as directed by sponsor.
- 4. Every cheerleader will attend cheerleading camp, if offered.
- 5. Every cheerleader will attend summer practice which will begin after summer camp. A practice schedule will be given to each cheerleader.
- 6. Lack of cooperation, unsatisfactory performance, and behavior that reflects poorly on Gore Schools will be grounds for dismissal.
- 7. A cheerleader must be passing all subjects to be eligible to cheer each week.

Because of school expenses for camp, equipment, etc., cheerleaders will be expected to complete an entire year of cheerleading.

The High School Cheer Coach will develop a yearly policy that shall be board approved that will govern all cheerleading with the above referenced items as guiding factors. This yearly policy will supersede any conflict with these 7 guidelines.
