GORE BOARD OF EDUCATION POLICY

The Gore Board of Education believes that student participation in athletics is an important part of the educational process. Therefore, participation will be encouraged.

However, the board also believes that athletic education is an adjunct to the regular curriculum and that certain criteria must be met by each participant to insure that no undue emphasis is placed in anyone area. The superintendent is directed to establish minimum standards and criteria. No student shall be permitted to participate in football, basketball, track, band, baseball, cheer leading, or other similar spor or activity unless the required criteria is met.

High school competitive athletics are for those students enrolled full time in grade 9 through 12. Ninth grade students may participate in both high school and "Jr. High" competitions not to exceed OSSAA regulations. Upper Elementary students shall be allowed to participate as per OSSAA regulations.
