I regret to inform you that your child, (name), has been temporarily suspended from school pending a hearing to be conducted before me in the principal's office. From the investigation, it was determined that your child was involved in the following misconduct and/or violation of district or school rules or regulations:

Your child is entitled to a hearing before the district superintendent, then the district's suspension appeal's committee and then may be appealed to the district's board of education to determine if he/she violated the rules in the manner stated above and whether he/she should be suspended for more than ten school days, not to extend beyond the current and the next succeeding school term. If you desire a hearing, please notify the principal's office at 918-489-5587 within five (5) days; that is, by(date). If you request a hearing, it will be scheduled as soon as practicable at a mutually convenient time. Your child will remain on temporary suspension until the hearing is held. If you do not request a hearing within five days, you will waive the right to a hearing, and the principal will enter an order suspending your child for more than ten school days if he/she deems it appropriate.  Please be advised that at a hearing your child may be represented by you, another adult, or an attorney and may seek to refute any allegations of misconduct. If he/she is represented by someone other than yourself, please advise the principal prior to the hearing.
At a hearing you and your child may present any witnesses or documentary evidence in an effort to refute the charges of misconduct and on the issue of a proper punishment, if it is determined that the misconduct occurred.
If you request a hearing, the school's administration will provide you with a list of the witnesses who will testify on behalf of the administration, together with a short description of their testimony. Documents may also be used at the hearing. If so, a copy of the documents will be provided to you prior to the hearing.
